In exercise of the powers conferred by section 18 of the Kerala Devaswom Recruitment Board Act, 2015 (16 of 2015), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Devaswom Recruitment Board Rules, 2015 issued by notification under G.O. (P) No. 216/2015/RD dated 30th May, 2015 and published as S.R.O. No. 352/2015 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1303 dated 30th May, 2015, namely:—



RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Devaswom Recruitment Board (Amendment) Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the rules.*—In the Kerala Devaswom Recruitment Board Rules, 2015,—

(1) in rule 2,—

(i) after clause (a), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(aa) “Candidates belonging to economically weaker sections of Hindu unreserved communities” mean those candidates whose family fulfill the eligibility criteria as specified in rule 2A.”;

(ii) after clause (b), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(ba) “family” means the person who seeks the benefit of reservation, his parents, his spouse and children/siblings below the age of 18 years.”;

(2) after rule 2, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“2A. *Members belonging to Economically Weaker Sections of Hindu Unreserved Communities.*—The members of the following family shall be eligible to be treated as members of economically weaker sections, namely:—

(i) a family which does not consist of a regular employee of the Central or State Government, Public Sector Undertakings, Co-operative Sector, Government aided autonomous bodies, educational institutions getting financial aids or grants from any Central or State Governments or the local bodies:

Provided that this clause does not apply to part-time employees and temporary employees.

(ii) a family which does not consist of a member who is an income tax payee;

(iii) a family which does not own more than one acre of land; and

(iv) a family which does not consist of a member who is having a gross monthly income of rupees twenty five thousand and above, from all sources put together.”;

(3) in sub-rule (2) of rule 3, for the existing proviso and illustration the following provisos and illustration shall be substituted, namely:—

“Provided that the posts reserved in the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958 for the non-Hindu backward communities, shall be divided among the Hindu communities as given below:—

Provided further that in these rules in every cycle of 100 vacancies and out of every 100 appointment 50 shall be from open competition and 50 shall be reserved for the Hindu communities as detailed below:—

Provided also that in order to claim reservation under the category of economically weaker sections of the Hindu unreserved communities, a candidate shall produce a certificate issued by the Village Officer in Form No. III appended to these rules to the effect that he



belongs to the economically weaker sections of Hindu unreserved communities as specified in rule 2A of these rules.”.

(4) in sub-rule (2) of rule 7, in the second proviso, after the words “reservation of appointment to” the words and symbol “economically weaker sections of Hindu unreserved communities,” shall be inserted;

(5) for the existing Annexure, after sub-rule (10) of rule 11, the following Annexure shall be substituted, namely:—

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Government have framed the Kerala Devaswom Recruitment Board Rules, 2015 by notification issued under G.O. (P) No. 216/2015/RD, dated 30th May, 2015 and published as S.R.O. No. 325/2015 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.1303 dated 30th May, 2015 and which was later amended vide notification issued under G.O. (P) No. 41/2016/RD, dated 19th January, 2016 and published as S.R.O. No. 56/2016 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 127 dated 20th January, 2016 and notification issued under G.O. (P) No. 77/2018/RD dated 28th November, 2018 and published as S.R.O. No. 881/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 3092 dated 10th December, 2018 respectively.

As per the Kerala Devaswom Recruitment Board Rules, 2015 the posts reserved in the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958 for the non-Hindu Backward Communities were treated as Open Merit Quota. Now, Travancore Devaswom Board, Cochin Devaswom Board, Guruvayoor Devaswom Managing Committee and Koodalmanickam Devaswom Managing Committee have decided to reconsider this and distribute the quota for non-Hindu Backward Communities among economically weaker sections of Hindu unreserved communities, Ezhavas, Thiyyas, Billavas, Scheduled Castes and Other Backward Communities mentioned in item 8 under sub-rule (1) of rule 17 of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958. The criteria for determining economically weaker section is yet to be decided by Government. Hence, it has become necessary to evolve a criteria for the recruitment process carried on by the Kerala Devaswom Recruitment Board. It necessitates a new order of reservation and rotation different from that specified in the Annexure to the Kerala Devaswom Recruitment Board Rules, 2015. Accordingly, Government have decided to make necessary amendments in the said rules.

The notification is intended to achieve the above purpose.
